**Q:** I'm feeling stressed about keeping up with bills each month. Where do I even start?

**A:** Start with a simple monthly budget! List your income, your must-pay expenses (like housing and utilities), and then track where the rest of your money is going. Small changes, such as cutting one subscription or planning meals at home, can quickly free up cash. The key is to write it down and review it regularly.

## FEATURED BOARD MEMBER



**Brad Lunsford**

Judge Bradley P. Lunsford (Ret.) graduated from Penn State in 1986. While he was in law school, his wife secured a position with the State College Area School District. After completing his degree, he followed her to Centre County, where he began his career as an Assistant Public Defender. Deeply committed to the community, Judge Lunsford became the Central Pennsylvania Coordinator of the Make-

A-Wish Foundation and was active in the State College Elks. Over the course of more than 20 years, he served on numerous charitable boards, ultimately continuing his public service as a County Judge. When invited to serve on the Arize Federal Credit Union Board, Judge Lunsford initially questioned what he could contribute, noting that his background was in law rather than finance, aside from a few economics classes he had taken at Penn State. However, he quickly recognized that Arize sought board members who could strengthen its community outreach efforts—an opportunity that deeply resonated with him. Judge Lunsford is particularly proud of Arize’s partnership with the Heart of JCo in Huntingdon, which has provided vital support for children in need. He also highlights the Credit Union’s outreach efforts with the Centre County Children’s Advocacy Center and its trade school scholarship fund. For Judge Lunsford, it is this focus on serving children that makes the most meaningful impact across the region.

### Monitor Your Credit

### Check Statements Regularly

  - Set up account alerts to get notified when transactions post.
  - Report any suspicious activity immediately so we can help protect your account.
